Whether it's your first visit or your 100th. we hope you enjoy the peace and serenity of IBSP's 3.000 acres and 10 miles of undeveloped coastline. A gem of the NJ State Park system, IBSP is a tranquil oasis quietly tucked away from the nearby bustling Jersey Shore towns, offering pristine white sand beaches, towering sand dunes, miles of ecologically diverse Barnegat Bay shoreline, 9 distinct and nationally recognized plant communities, and tremendous wildlife biodiversity! As you can imagine, it is quite a delicate balance for Park staff to ensure a positive visitors' experience while preserving and protecting the islands natural resources. Park staff work tirelessly throughout the year achieve this mission and these are a few of the notable happenings: 1) Judges Shack has been nominated for the National Register of Historic Places, 2) Sea Beach Amaranth, a State and federallylisted plant, is making a comeback in the Park, 3) brand new merchandise is available at the park office, 4) the Tidal Pond Trail has been safely re-routed to the west as a result of severe bayside erosion and 5) new trail markers were installed on each beach access path.

It is our mission to preserve IBSP for future generations and we kindly ask for your support and effort along the way. Please enjoy all that the park has to offer, but please respect the rules and regulations! Always remember to bring your trash home with you, stay on marked trails, enjoy wildlife from a distance and most importantly, leave IBSP a little better than you found it!
